Stuart and thousands of Confederate soldiers.

Meet at the Hollywood Cemetery entrance at Cherry and Albemarle streets, near the rear of the stone structure to the left.

\$15 per person, \$5 for Valentine Members and children ages 12 and under. Tour guides accept cash or check. Charge in advance by calling the Valentine. Admission includes a \$5 donation to the Friends of Hollywood Cemetery for ongoing restoration.

Please note that this tour is 1.5 to 2 miles and involves several inclines. Comfortable shoes and water are recommended.
